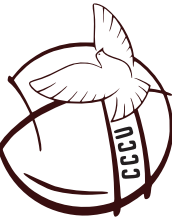
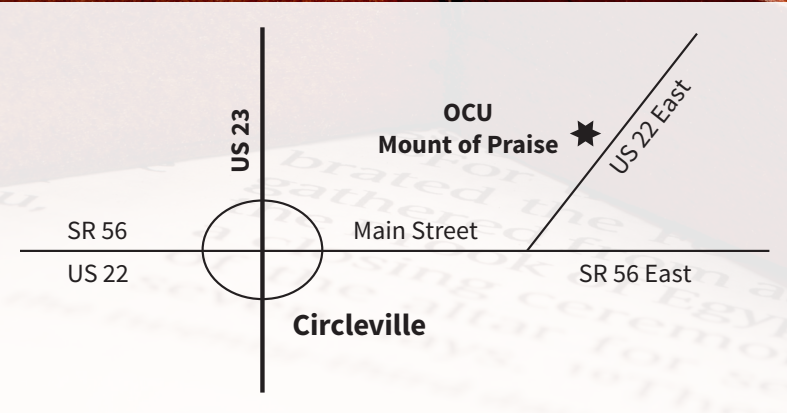

Camp Information

Lodging: Some rooms will be available in the Ohio Christian University dormitories for family, couples, or individual accommodations for \$20.00 per night. Contact Mrs. Joanne Hawk at 740-572-0089 for reservations.

Meals: Meals will be served three times each day in the university dining room. Breakfast is \$7.00, Lunch \$9.00 and Supper \$10.00.

Teens: Teenagers entering the seventh grade to graduate seniors may enroll in the Teens of Praise Camp. Housing and meals are included in the registration fee. The teen program begins on Sunday afternoon June 21, and runs through Saturday afternoon, June 27. The camp check-in will be on **Sunday, June 21 from 2:00-3:00 p.m. in the lobby of the Maxwell Center at Ohio Christian University.** Campers must pre-register online. Children: The children's services will be under the direction of Greg and Becky Gardner. Services are 10:30 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. (Sunday evenings at 6:00 P.M.) Ages K-6 grade.
