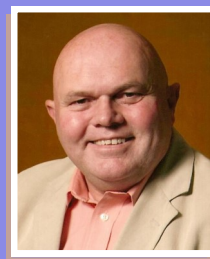
OUR WORKERS

Don and Shirl reside in Indianapolis and have one son, Eric, wife Deborah and four grandchildren.



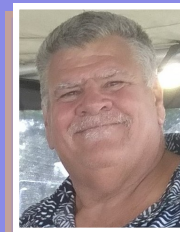
